

Claire McGibbon's Supply List 2017 – 2018

All materials besides emergency packs will be turned into the classroom and returned to students as needed. Please do not put names on anything. Please do not send personal art supplies or material pouches as all supplies will be communal during the school year.

Returning students - 2nd and 3rd grade

- 24 Ticonderoga pencils (plain yellow old-school color-no fancy pencils, no black pencils!)
- 2 packages disinfectant wipes (no clorox please)
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 pack graph paper
- 6 wide rule composition books (for subject journals...ok if you have them)
- 1 pack thicker white art paper
- 2 new stitch-bound wide rule composition books with lines. Patterns are good, and quality is important.
- 2 new pocket folders with prongs
- 2 plastic pocket folders (one for finished work, one for unfinished work)
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 set paint brushes (including 3 or more brushes of different sizes)
- one box of chalk pastels
- 1 emergency pack—a ziploc bag with your child's name on it containing a change of clothes, non-perishable foods, and an emergency blanket.

New Students - 1st grade

- 24 Ticonderoga pencils (plain yellow old-school color—no fancy pencils, no black pencils!)
- 2 packages disinfectant wipes
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 pack thicker white art paper
- 6 stitch bound wide rule composition books with lines - good quality and multiple patterns
- 3 two pocket folders with prongs
- 2 plastic pocket folders (one for finished work, one for unfinished work)
- 1 box of colored pencils (usually have 12-24 pencils)
- 1 box oil pastels
- 1 set paint brushes (including 3 or more brushes of different sizes)
- 1 emergency pack—a ziploc bag with your child's name on it containing a change of clothes, non-perishable foods, and an emergency blanket.

Additional Items by Grade

1st grade

- 1 pack of multiple colored dry erase markers

2nd grade

- 1 pack notebook paper
- 1 ruler

3rd grade

- 1 set of watercolor paints (used is great)
